Rajeswari, HOD, ECE department delivered the welcome address. Dr. S. Uma Maheswari, Co-ordinator of the programme, presented the overview of the programme. Dr. M. P. Ganesh, Assistant Professor, Department of Management Studies, IIT Madras inaugurated the function.
