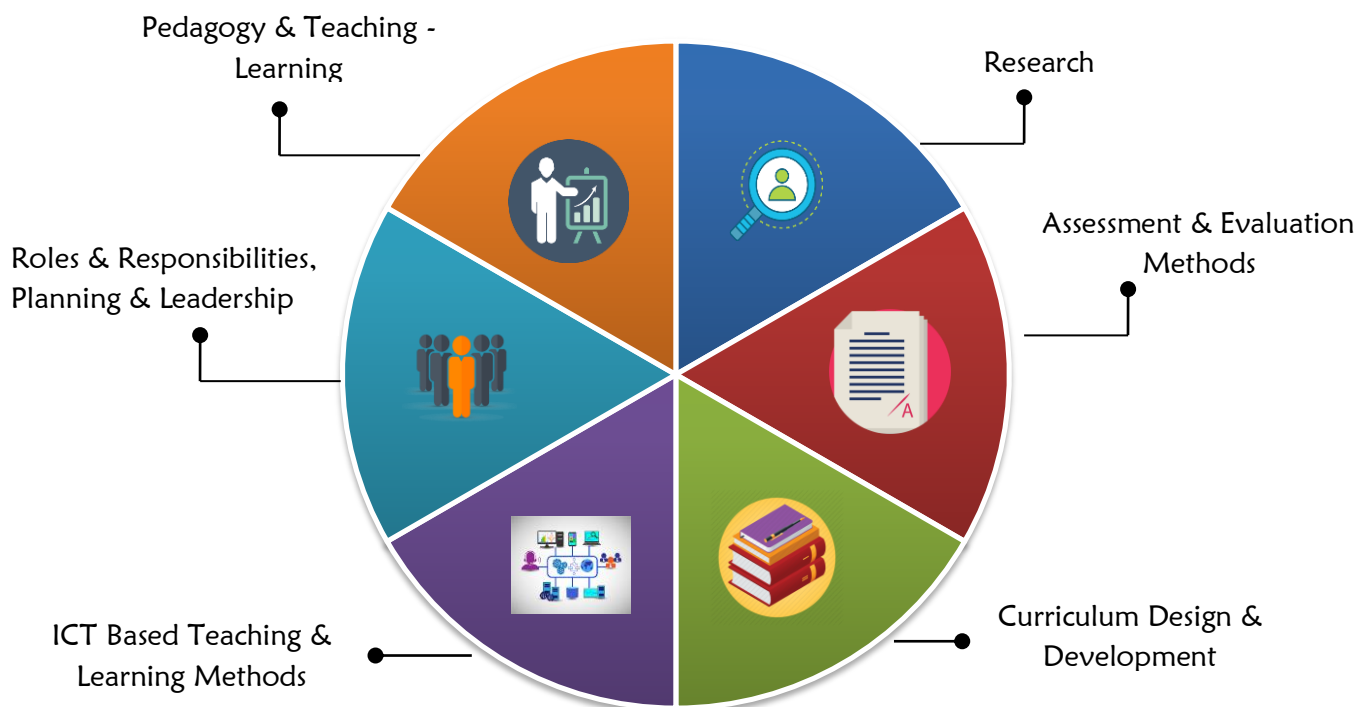

About the Programme

The cornerstone of any education system is teachers and the quality of education is both determined and dependent on the quality of its teachers. In higher education, faculty development is central to the issues of quality and excellence. The Induction Programme for training Faculty members in Engineering Institutions, and universities will familiarize them in their roles as freshly inducted higher education teachers. It will orient them on various generic aspects of teaching learning, instructional methodologies, assessment and evaluation techniques, ICT enabled teaching learning, and equip them with knowledge of University rules and regulations, basics of governance and administration. The Induction programme for teachers shall prepare and skill the new recruits in inculcating the highest standards of teaching and learning including the latest developments. The programme is carefully designed to provide insights on empowering the young teachers with required skills and competencies to teach the digital natives.

The Group of Secretaries on Education and Social Development has recommended this Mandatory Induction Training for freshly inducted faculty members in Universities/ Institutes so as to improve the quality of education.

As per the Latest regulations issued by UGC dated 18/07/2018, induction programmes conducted by PMMMNTT SoE's ,TLCs etc shall be treated at par with the Orientation Programmes already being run by the Human Resource Development Centres of the UGC for the purpose of the CAS requirements making faculty eligible for On Duty leave.

As per MHRD guidelines it is mandatory for newly recruited faculty members in technical institutions to undergo an induction programme after their appointment in Higher Education Institutions
